Ray Malinosky – AnnaMae Davis, Diane Parker – Title V acceptance. At a previous meeting Mr. Malinosky presented a water test with a level high level of Toluene. Sally wanted clarification from Arthur Quinn prior to issuing Title V acceptance. The system was flushed and levels dropped from 50 to 0.85 ppm. The acceptable limit is 1000. Evidently, grease residue on the pipe was the reason for the high level.

- 2. Variance to 310 CMR 15.211 (1) The proposed SAS does not meet the required setback from a property line 10ft required 6ft provided from a public street.
- 3. Variance to 310 CMR 15.221 (1) The proposed SAS does not meet the required setback from a property line 10ft required 6ft provided from Lord property line.
- 4. Variance to 310 CMR 15.221 (1) The proposed SAS does not meet the required setback from a well 100ft required 56ft provided MacDonald well.
- 5. Variance to 310 CMR 15.221 (1) The proposed SAS does not meet the required setback from a well 100ft required 82ft provided Kaufman well.

Mr. MacDonald had questions about well testing a recourse in the event something went wrong. Sally informed Mr. MacDonald in that event the should pursue a civil remedy.

Variances granted. The Kingstons also wanted a well permit, but a site plan showing distances to neighboring septics was not presented.
