The Holland Board of Selectmen will hold a public meeting to discuss the town's Community Development Strategy at **6:00 PM on Tuesday, November 21, 2017** at the Holland Town Hall located at 27 Sturbridge Road, Holland, MA.

Representatives from the Pioneer Valley Planning Commission and town officials will discuss the strategy which identifies the town's community development priorities. The strategy is to be presented as a supportive document in a competitive grant application through the Massachusetts Department of Housing and Community Development Block Grant program. General priorities include housing rehabilitation, public facilities and infrastructure improvements, social service projects, planning activities, the removal of architectural barriers and economic development initiatives. The strategy also prioritizes specific projects for which funding may be sought.

The town of Holland is also concerned with regional activities that are also funded through the block grant program and continues to collaborate with neighboring communities. As such, regional priorities and activities will also be discussed.
