8:00 p.m. Gary Barker of 11 Pine Tree Dr. sought our advice on the repair of an existing lakeside concrete wall. Following discussion, he will return with written plans.

8:20 p.m. Mark Farrell of Green Hill Engineering questioned what requirements would Ernest Riley of 62 Sturbridge Rd. need in order to build a garage with a bathroom. Mark Farrell was informed that a Procedure Sheet would be needed.

8:30 p.m. Tom Flannery of 10 Pine Tree Dr. was issued Procedure Sheet #2007-1212 to repair a septic system at his newly purchased property at 16 Old County Rd. Motion was made to approve the project since there were no conservation issues. All were in favor. Mary vandenBerg signed the Procedure Sheet.

Motion to adjourn was made, seconded and approved by all. Meeting adjourned at 8:50 p.m.
