Minutes of Commission meeting held on June 29, 2004.

Present: Mary vandenBerg, Chairperson, Steven Anderstrom, Patricia Caron, Howard Fife, Art Fusco, Helen Kreiger and James Wettlaufer.

7:00 p.m. Chairperson called the meeting to order.

7:05 p.m. Debbie Tierney graciously witnessed and notarized the signatures of the HCC members for the Order of Conditions for Project File #184-176 for Shirley Catsavas.

7:15 p.m. Minutes of Commission Meeting held on June 22, 2004 were read. Motion made by Steven Anderstrom to accept the minutes as read seconded by Helen Kreiger and accepted by all.

7:20 p.m. **Old Business**

The HCC received a Certified Letter sent on June 24, 2004 from Raymond and Barbara Korny. The letter contained concerns of a road, approximately 30' wide by 1½ to 2 miles long being cut into the woods, the removal and/or replacement of a culvert. The Korny's are concerned that new wetlands are being created on their property.

Also, Mary vandenBerg received a phone call from a Mr. Griffin from the New England Environmental in Amherst, MA stating that he had received a call from Thomas Gould requesting him to do wetlands evaluation. He was to meet with Mr. Gould on Wednesday, June 30, 2004.

Art Fusco made a motion that a Cease and Desist Order be issued to Thomas Gould seconded by James Wettlaufer. All were in favor. Mr. Gould may be in violation of Wetlands Regulation under M.G.L. c. 131, para. 40 and requires a Notice of Intent. The Enforcement Order will be sent by Certified Mail. A copy is also being sent to the Springfield DEP.

8:20 p.m. Robert Scott appeared before the HCC and was informed that we are still investigating the types of plants that can be used along his "Coir Log" wall. Mark Farrell is presently investigating for the HCC.

8:30 p.m. Procedure Sheet #03-0865 issued to owner Adina Marcucci. Cindy Poirier, Realtor represented William R. Cantell of 3 Marcy Pl., Map 22-B-2. to build a single-family dwelling. Motion to approve this project as shown on the stamped plans indicating a silt fence between the work area and wetlands was made by Steven Anderstrom seconded by Helen Kreiger and approved by all. Procedure sheet signed by Mary vandenBerg.

8:45 p.m. The HCC received on June 24, 2004 a Certified package sent by Jalbert Engineering containing 2 Notices of Intent with enclosed File Nos. from the DEP.

File No. 184-177 assigned to Elias Hanna, project location Lot 4, 88 Sturbridge Rd., Map B-46.4;

File No. 184-178 assigned to Elias Hanna, project location Lot 5, 90 Sturbridge Rd., Map B-46.5.

Public Hearings will be held on July 20, 2004 at 7:30 and 8:00 p.m. Legal Ads will be posted in The Republican.

A Check of \$137.50 for a "Notice of Intent" filing fee was included for each notice.
