Mr. Earl Johnson (Planning Board) presented documentation on the Haven property that indicated the HCC on 7/27/77 issued a determination of applicability which listed various lots were subject to the Wetlands Protection Act and shall require the filing of a N.O.I. Also presented was a memo from the Board of Assessors indicating that a lot that is part of the parcel under review by the HCC (Mr. Ardizzoni's Plan) has been sold by Mr Haven. Mr. Mark Farrell, Green Hill Engineering, joined the meeting and further discussion continued. As the above action has an impact on the N.O.I. and the Request for Determination filed by Mr. Ardizzoni, the final review of these documents was put on hold. No further action taken. Mr Farrell to look into the situation

Mr. Mark Zulkiewicz from Muirfield Development and Mark Farrell brought the HCC up to date on the project.

Brad gave a financial report on our Wetlands Protection Account.

Received a Forrest Cutting Plan for cutting on Artruc and Norcross property Owner indicated as Mr. Artruc. Howie to follow up with State Forester. Another plan was received from Tetreault to cut property off Mashapaug Road between the temporary Police station and the Market. Brad to ask Tetreault to attend next Tuesday's meeting and present a plan that indicates where the landing area is and to get Highway Dept approval. Howie also took this one to follow up on.
