The public will not be allowed into a Board/Committee meeting, even where there are any members of the public body and/or [city/town] staff or official(s) physically present at the meeting location during the meeting. "Public comment" portions of meetings will be temporarily suspended.

# **Extending Holland Municipal Closures:**

Per Governor Baker's COVID-19 Order 21 made on March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2020 to have non-essential businesses stay closed until May 4<sup>th</sup>, 2020. The select Board will be extending the Library and the Community Center's closures until May 4<sup>th</sup>, 2020, as well.

**Motion 04072020-2:** Mr. Mandell made a motion extend all of the Municipal closures until May 4<sup>th</sup>, 2020.

### **Legislative Taxpayers Bill Discussion:**

The State does not want us to change the date of when people are supposed to pay taxes. The SB are able to waive the interest and penalties. There is a deadline on how far we are able to extend the date.

(to extend the time that a citizen has to apply for a real estate tax exemption).
