 - \circ JJ advised he will be do all digging by hand, then pour concrete 10x14 space.
 - o JJ advised he will place haybales along shoreline.
 - o Determination of Applicability Motion made for negative determination so no NOI required.

RDA signed by members with the condition that haybales be placed along shoreline.

 - o <u>Abutters Present</u>: Charlene Henault-Henchy, 30 Stony Hill Road; Audrey & Ronald Leighton, 32 Stony Hill Road; Roberta Kuhnly, 28 Stony Hill Road.
 - o MF drew attention to drawings. Would like to add 2 retaining walls down by water to terrace the land.
 - o MF claims it would be set back about a foot from the edge of the shore
 - o On terraces, grass would be grown or sand will be added.
 - o JW discussed location of floodline & calculation on compensatory storage.
 - JW stress cannot go beyond the high water mark-must make sure you do not increase the flood capacity of your neighbor.
 - o MF stated it would be equal. Claims he would not be trying to gain land and fill the reservoir. Cut material out which would result in leveling.
 - o Roberta Kuhnly concerned with the erosion of her property MF stated it would not accelerate RK's erosion problem but erosion would continue at the current rate.
 - o MF advised he would take the existing rocks from the shoreline of 30 Stony Hill and place on 28's shoreline.
