7:20 p.m. We received from Andy Goodhall of Malibu Properties a letter requesting a Certificate of Compliance for Michael and Holly Rutkowski of 22 Stony Hill Rd. Motion made by Howard Fife that a Request for a Certificate of Compliance be sent to them. Seconded and approved by all.

8:00 p.m. Robert Sullivan came to the HCC, as suggested by James Wettlaufer, to assist him in filling out a Notice of Intent regarding the Vinton Rd. runoff onto his property. He stated that Terry O'Keefe, contractor would remove the sand with a backhoe once the lake is drawn down, bringing the sand to the Highway Dept. The Notice of Intent was partially completed by the HCC and the remaining section is to be completed by Mr. Sullivan.
