Mark Farrell of Green Hill Engineering brought in a map with a proposed well and septic system for Lynn Arnold's property on 9 Shore Drive. Following discussion, motion made by Mary vandenBerg to leave the well's spoilings trench open until project is completed. Seconded and approved by all.
