7:00 p.m. Reading of the minutes of the previous meeting of October 28, 2003, was accepted by all and signed by Steven Anderstrom, Acting Chairman


7:30 p.m. The Public Hearing regarding a Notice of Intent for Anthony Ianniccheri, DEP File No. 184-161 was held and presented by Mark Farrell of Green Hill Engineering. Also present was abutter Tom Riley. The Notice of Intent was approved. The hearing closed at 7:50 pm. All signed the Order of Conditions.

7:55 p.m. Paul Gillis appeared before the HCC with a map of the proposed Senior Center Site, which had previously been discussed. He was instructed that prior to any commencement work on the site, adequate erosion and sedimentation control measures should be implemented and maintained throughout the entire project.

8:10 p.m. The Public Hearing of Lorraine and William Cromack presented by Mark Farrell of Green Hill Engineering for a Request of Determination of Applicability replacing the existing septic system at 32 Lakeshore Dr. was held. Present was Marguerite Choquette who suggested that the trench be dug seven feet (7') away from her pine trees within the 10' easement. The Cromacks had no objections. A Negative Determination was issued by the HCC. The hearing closed at 8:40 pm. The Determination of Non-Applicability will be presented at the next HCC meeting for signatures.
