Minutes of Conservation Commission held on March 24, 2020

Meeting called to order at 6:32 pm by Jessica Chaffee, Chair

Approval of Minutes from 3/10/2020: Kaitlin made a motion to approve the minutes from 3/10/2020. Sam seconded. All in favor; motion passed with a yes vote from the following members who were present on 3/10/2020 (Kathy, Marcia, Jessica, Kaitlin and Sam). Dawn abstained.

- 3/10/2020: From Brian Haughey to department heads with a PDF attached with information to share regarding the Corona Virus.

- 3/24/2020: From Mike Bogazt regarding 2 trees to be removed. He sent pictures. *(Kathy responded asking for the distance from the Lake and suggesting he complete a Tree Removal Application.)*
- 3/24/2020: MACC reminder that on 3/25/2020 there is a free webinar at 12 noon on vernal pools.

Review New Tree Removal Applications:

- DB Tree's concern— Kaitlin will write a letter to the home owner indicating that the there appears to have been a violation of the Wetlands Protection Act. The homeowner will be asked to address Conservation's concerns at a future meeting.
- No new tree removal applications have been submitted.

Plan site visits prior to next meeting:

- **29 Lakeridge/Bedards:** Jessica will send out electronic plans. **Note:** Both Jessica and Katilin will abstain from this hearing.
- **42 Over-the-Top Road:** Kaitlin will take on the task of drafting the OOC before the next meeting.

Round Table:

- **Site Visits:** All site visits will be conducted independently by members due to social distancing. Members are asked to take pictures and send them with proper labeling to the Conservation email. Jessica noted that due to social distancing only she and Sam went on the site visits this week.
- **22 Collette Drive/Mike Swanson (follow-up on a complaint):** Mike is rebuilding a waterfront wall and equipment was staged in the buffer zone near the lake. He did not check with Conservation regarding permitting for this project. It was determined that he be allowed to finish the wall as quickly as possible because the water level was returning to normal and this option was deemed to be less damaging to the lake than ordering him to cease work. The owner will plan to donate 5 trees to the Town of Holland for mitigation as there is no place on the property to plant them. He will also be filing a NOI for this project.
42 Over-the-Top: The owners were in the process of filing an NOI; however, the existing cottage was demolished prior to the NOI hearing. According to the Lauzon's, the Building Inspector issued a permit for the demolition, however, they were unable to produce the building permit for the Conservation Commission at the time of the meeting. The Lauzon's were asked to install straw wattles for erosion control in the mean time, and they quickly complied. ConCom instructed the Lauzon's that no more work is to be done on their proposed project until the NOI has been officially approved.

- **Discussion:** Steve had emailed Conservation indicating that he wanted the Commission to understand the efforts he has made to reduce impacts to the resource area, specifically Hamilton Reservoir. Given that single-family residences are exempt from Stormwater Management Standards and that the actual impervious area is reduced in the current proposal – then Standard #3 for recharge is met by default. The reduction in impervious area also reduces the amount of stormwater runoff, complying Standard #2. Standard #1 is also met as this proposal does not create any untreated discharges. The OOC was drafted based on taking into account Steve's input. Paul and Theresa Les were asked to mitigate their project by planting 3 saplings with one being planted near the lake.

Motion: Kaitlin made a motion to approve the OOC for NOI #184-0371/19 Island Road/Paul and Theresa Les with the inclusion of 3 Saplings to be planted, at least one near the lake. Dawn seconded.

Robbin Lauzon/42 Over-the-Top Road
Project: Demo/Rebuild

Public Hearing Opened at 7:15 pm

Persons in Attending Remotely: Chairperson, Jessica Chaffee; Kaitlin Laabs; Kathy McKenna; Marcia Beal; Sam Spratlin; Dawn Kamay; Robbin & Anthony Lauzon (owner); Rich Lauzone (abutter).

- **Discussion:** Concerns were raised about the house demolition that occurred before tonight's Public NOI Hearing was held. According to the Lauzon's, they were issued a permit by Jack Keough to demo the house. Jessica asked if they could provide Conservation with a copy of the permit. She indicated that a scanned copy via email would be acceptable. Jessica had made a site visit and asked the Lauzon's to place straw wattles as a sediment barrier. They complied quickly with this request. The current plan was discussed. Previously Robbin indicated that the house would be set on piers with no digging necessary; however, tonight she indicated that they wanted to dig out an area under the house/deck that would have a cement pad. This may require machinery, but she wasn't sure. Robbin also noted the foundation would be enclosed with cement blocks. Jessica asked that they label the erosion control areas on the plan, the limit of work, and areas where shrubs will be planted.

Robbin and Anthony Lauzon asked to continue this Public Hearing to the next Conservation meeting that is to be held on 4/14/2020.

Project: Retaining Wall

Kaitlin was hoping that they could get the work done in one day. They are anticipating a few days to complete the job. The work will need to be done in dry conditions with at least a 3-day outlook of no rain. Any material that needs to be stockpiled must be tarped. Home owners will need to contact ConCom if they are unable to complete the wall within time frame of 1-3 days.

- **Discussion:** They will be adding an upper floor with dormers to the house and also want to add a deck. Only a small portion of the deck is in the buffer zone. Most of the proposed project is outside of the 100-foot buffer zone. The area near the house and deck is relatively level, and there is an existing block wall which serves as a natural barrier prior to the slope that heads toward the lake. No excavation will take place on the lake side of the project; however, they will need to dig for deck piers. It was deemed that no conditions would be necessary.
