Old Business

Select Boards response to utility poles: Select board has not discussed the issue yet, but Larry has called them and is awaiting a response.

HMGP Grant: Spoke to Michelle O'Tool, mitigation grant coordinator. A cost analysis was required for this grant and LOC would not have been able to apply in time. She recommended applying for several different grants, but they all require a cost analysis. Announcements for these grants will be coming up later this summer. It was recommended this cost analysis to be done ahead of time to asses what funding could be brought to the table.

• Suggest approaching the select board at our next joint meeting and asking if the town could use the funds set aside for a grant writer and hire someone to apply for these grants. The next joint meting will be on 8/6/19.

Lake Maintenance Contract with Lake Solitude: Lake Association will cover the cost of the next two water quality test. The contract needs to be renewed however. A one year contract is under \$30,000, can this skip the biding process and renew one year at a time?

New Business
