East Brimfield Rd from the intersection of **Sturbridge Rd** to the intersection of **Dug Hill Rd** will be closed to through traffic on **Saturday, October 29, 2022**, beginning at approximately **5:00 PM**, and ending at approximately **8:00 PM**. This road closure will be in place in order to accommodate the Holland Elementary School PTO Trunk or Treat event.

Vehicles that are participating in the event should enter at the **East Brimfield Rd / Sturbridge Rd intersection**. Traffic will not be authorized to enter this section of East Brimfield Rd via the Dug Hill Rd intersection until the road closure is terminated. **Parking for vehicles participating in the event will end promptly at 6:15 PM**, and trick or treating is scheduled to begin at 6:30 PM.

ONLY vehicles that are PARTICIPATING in the event will be authorized to park on East Brimfield Rd.

Please note: If the event is postponed on October 29th due to inclement weather, the event will take place on Saturday, November 5, 2022, during the same time frame. These road closure and parking restrictions will apply to November 5th if the event is rescheduled. Please see the attached map and PTO flyer for specific event details.

The restrictions contained herein are authorized pursuant to Town of Holland general bylaws, specifically c. 9 §9.2.5.2, and may be subject to change without notice at any time.

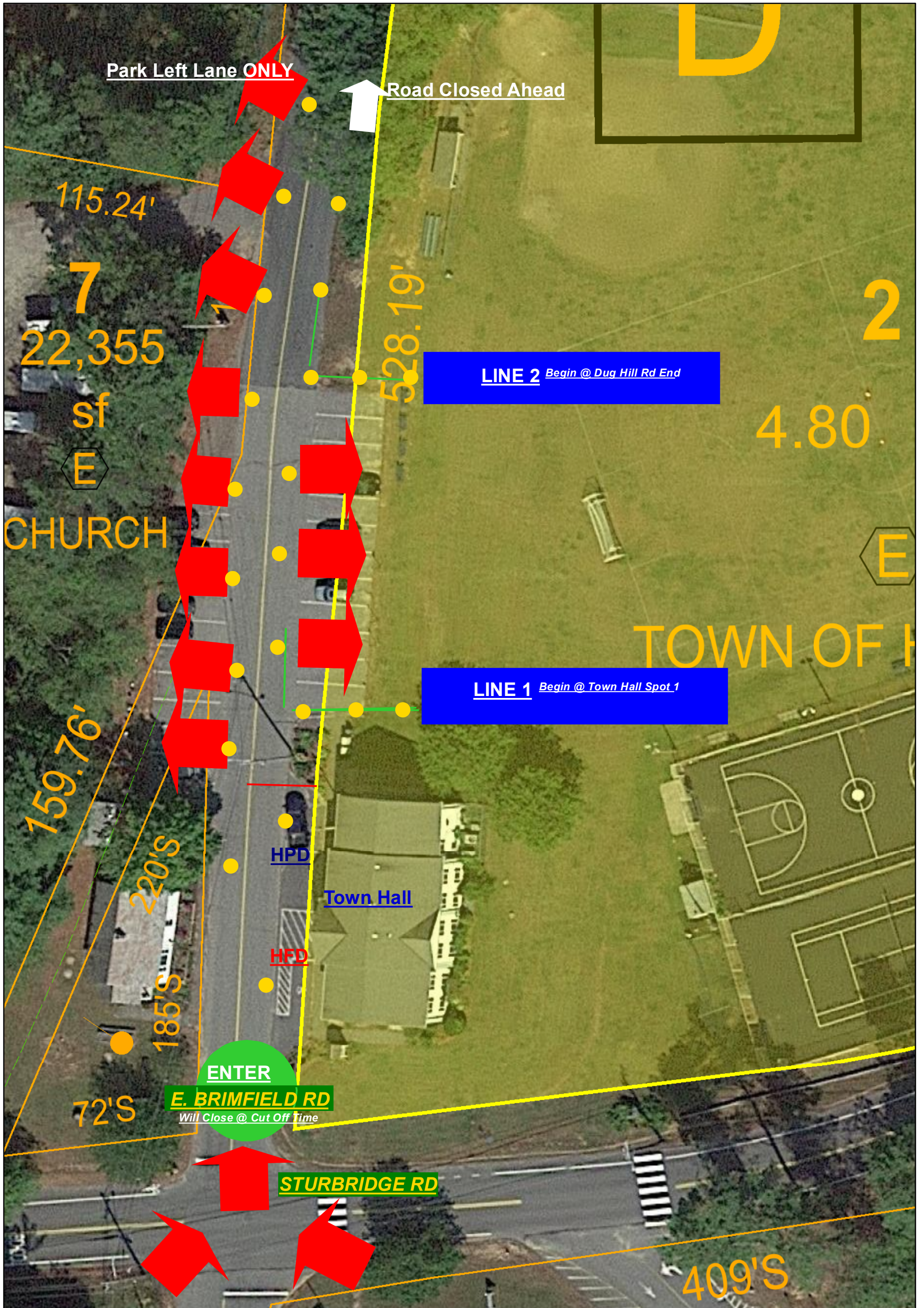

Trunk or Treat is an alternative to trick or treating from house to house. The road is closed off to traffic and is patrolled by Holland Police. Families then go from car to car in a safe and controlled setting.



In order to make Trunk or Treat a success, all participants MUST contribute. We ask that each family pass out candy from a trunk (decorating optional, but highly encouraged). Please plan on a minimum of 350+ pieces of candy. **If you are unable to park a vehicle, we ask that you bring candy to the PTO table, where we will have volunteers available to pass it out.**

*Additional parking for non-participants is available in the Holland Church parking lot.

There will be a meeting for those interested in volunteering at this event on Wednesday 10/12 at 6pm at Holland Elementary School.

5:30 PM: Vehicles will begin parking on East Brimfield Road with trunk facing out.

6:15 PM: Parking will be cut off.

6:30PM: Trunk or Treat begins when the fire engine sounds. Families should start at their vehicle and move counterclockwise.

All children must be accompanied by an adult. **NO DROP OFFS.**
