PUBLIC HEARINGS

 7:00 PM 7 Sunset Ln: NOI 184-0440. Michael Thibeault of Landscape Evolution speaking. Repair failing timber wall. RL & CJ note no issues to report from the site inspection. Reviewed comments from Mark Stinson (DEP). Thibeault agreed to add 8 bushes to the property. There is also an unrecorded COC from 2004 (184-0169). JW was able to locate the original COC, but there are no wet signatures on it, so it cannot be recorded. The Request for COC will be added to the agenda for the meeting scheduled for January 9, 2024.

7:07 PM RL Motion to Approve with conditions as stated and based on plan dated 11/18/2023; CJ 2nds; All in Favor. Motion Approved. SB uploaded OOC to eDEP. Copy of Order of Conditions (OOC) provided to Thibeault at meeting.

2. 7:10 PM 15 Alexander Rd: NOI 184-0440. In attendance are: Isobel Arthen-Long from Tighe & Bond; Michael Fitzback owner of 15 Alexander Rd; Amelita Lijek currently of Easthampton / incoming resident of 15 Alexander Rd; and, Kale Landers owner of 3 Alexander Rd. The NOI is for Utility work and tree removal. RL & CJ note no issues to report from the site inspection. Arthen-Long explained the project is being done in coordination with the Army Corps of Engineers, who hold an easement. 15 Trees will be removed within the 200' buffer. National Grid cannot adequately maintain the utility poles/wires on that property at their current location. Neighbor Landers noted that crews have to go down a 70-90° angled embankment to reach the pole(s). A truck cannot safety access that area. Owner Fitzback and incoming resident Lijek oppose this NOI. They are concerned crews might damage the bridge to their property. Arthen-Long states Tighe & Bond were under the impression the owner was in agreement with the project. JW asked Arthen-Long if National Grid or Tighe & Bond would be agreeable to put up a bond in the event there is damage to the property. She said she could not speak to whether either company would agree to that, but that she will look into it. She noted that if the project is not done, National Grid will not be able to guarantee consistent electric utility service to this property. The Commission will not vote on this NOI unless both parties are on the same page.

7:26 PM Arthen-Long requested a continuation to the next meeting scheduled January 9, 2024 to give the parties time to come to an agreement. Request Approved and Meeting Closed.
