

## **Holland Trails Committee Minutes**

Date: May 25, 2022

Present: Richard & Chris Haller, and Jackie Proko

Due to COVID-19 concerns, this meeting was convened remotely. The meeting was called to order at 7:11pm by Dick Haller. The minutes of the meeting held May 4th were approved.

Chris presented the treasurer's report. The balance is \$2,350.

### **Old Business**

The Land Grant for the Steven's Brook property was not extended. It expires June 30th, however the town can reapply. Rep. Smola and Senator Fattman are working to sequester the amount and to urge Land Court to act.

If anyone attended the Trails Skills College, that can be reimbursed for class fees and mileage.

### **New Business**

Dick talked to Brian Johnson about the Community Center Trail. The next time the Highway Department has a skid steer, they will scrape the walkway. The town does not have a box spreader. This is an item the committee could consider purchasing.

The Town Accountant has informed Dick that the Trails Committee has a gift account with about \$100. He will inform the Hoyt Foundation.

Discussion of the recycling program was postponed until Bob Pellicane is able to attend.

Expenditures for this year's budget were discussed. Dick will price lumber for bridge replacement and will check prices for a box spreader.

The calendar was discussed. It was decided to eliminate the kayak activity. Three fall events were scheduled. Dick will complete the Walktober application.

Our next meeting is scheduled for June 22nd. The latest word from the Commonwealth is that remote meetings are permissible at least until July 15th.

We will have a single meeting in July and August. It is scheduled for Wednesday, August 10th.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:41.
