1. Fields

The fields are "a mess" and need to be addressed. The fields are currently used by Soccer, Baseball Softball and Flag Football. There are overused and traffic continues to increase, the highest traffic is in the spring. There is no irrigation. Historically the fields have been mowed by John Smith for free and volunteers fixed the baseball, softball and teeball fields. The highway department is now mowing the fields 1x per week. Highway department recommends using turf pro (used at cemetery). Rec is paying for fertilizer and equipment repair.

Recommendation to review the overlay of soccer fields and rotate the fields. Also recommend encumbering money for this year and determine actual cost of the field maintenance. Highway department to provide hour rate and will begin to bill the rec committee. Once determined, submit for next year's budget. Look into the opportunity to write/apply for grants once position is filled. Talk to other towns about grants they have received to improve fields. Also look at other locations within the town (i.e. Circle H etc.) for future fields.

Goal: maintain fields for current usage and traffic levels.
