In preparation for the upcoming 2024 Ski Season, the Aqua Riders again request exemption from the following restrictions during scheduled practice times and special events shown in the table below. These allowances are necessary for us to adequately practice as a Team, teach new skills, use the water ski ramp, offer special events and to perform the multi-person acts associated with water ski shows.
