

Holland Trails Committee Minutes

Date: April 28, 2021

Present: Richard & Chris Haller, Bob Pellicane, and Brock Jenkins

Due to COVID-19 concerns, this meeting was convened remotely. The meeting was called to order at 7:04 PM by Dick Haller. The minutes of the meeting held March 24th were approved.

Chris presented the treasurer's report. The balance is \$2,350.

Old Business

Brock Jenkins is interested in joining the committee. Dick will submit his name to the Select Board.

Progress continues on the Sichol property, but two hurdles remain. As soon as a closing date is determined, we will need to move quickly to establish a parking area and install the kiosk by June 30th.

Rampco in Dudley will supply 7/8" minus crushed gravel for \$11.50 per ton, if the town will pick it up at the yard. Delivery would be an additional \$6.00 per ton. An 8 space parking area is well within our budget.

We will be redesigning the bulletin board at Town Hall.

New Business

A spring walk is planned for the Sichol property. We will meet on Blodgett Road at 10am on May 8th. A rain date is set for May 15th. Dick will invite Marcia Beal, Glen Colburn, and Ed hood. Google maps can be used to map the trail.

No parking signs have been placed by home owners at the end of Morse Road. A "fire lane" is claimed.

Lynne Peterson has pledged to fund the Brimfield bridge with a donation as much as \$104,000, if the bridge can be named for Christian Peterson.

The campsite on the Sichol property is occupied. The town attorney is concerned.

Our regularly scheduled meeting is the same date as the Annual Town Meeting. We will wait until we have a closing date to meet and will invite Stacy Stout and Brian Johnson to attend.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:38.
